2. Rules:

This Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of sailing 2017-2020

3. Eligibility and Entry:

The event is open to all PHRF, One design, Multi-Hull and Portsmouth boat

that register and pay the fee's. Boats racing in a PHRF fleet shall have a current PHRF certificate issued by the S.A.I.L PHRF Committee; otherwise, a non contestable PHRF rating will be assigned for a \$5 fee at the Open. Boats racing One design shall comply with their One Design Class rules. Portsmouth boats shall comply with all Portsmouth rules. Three boats will make a fleet.

4. Advance Registration:

5. Fees:

Entry fee does not include park passes for vehicles or boats, available at the Marina or Park entry station.

6. Measurement

Measurement shall be governed by the individual class associations. PHRF fleet boats should have a PHRF certificate issued by S.A.I.L. (see <u>rmsail.org</u> for more info)

7. Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions; (SI's) will be available at registration.

8. Regatta Site:

The regatta site will be at the North Pines Area of Carter Lake, Larimer County Recreation Area, west of Berthoud, Colorado.

9. Accommodations:

A limited number of complimentary slip spaces at the Carter Lake Sailing Club will be available on a first come, first serve basis through registration. Some additional moorings or slips will be available through the Carter Lake Marina. You can contact the Marina at 970-667-1062.

10. Racing Area and Courses:

Racing area will be shown on the Carter Lake Sailing Club Race Course Chart, available at registration.

12. Scoring:

The low point scoring system of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 will be used. All races sailed will be scored

13. Trophies:

Fleets with three boats will be awarded a first place trophy
Fleets with four boats will be awarded first and second place trophies.
Fleets with five or more boats will be awarded first, second and third place.
