Carter Lake Sailing Club Lady Victory Cup 2020 Notice of Race

1. Events:

The Carter Lake Sail Club (CLSC) will conduct its 2020 Lady Victory Cup Regatta at Carter Lake, Larimer County Recreation Area, west of Berthoud Colorado. CLSC is the organizing authority.

2. Rules:

This Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in "The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020", except as changed by this NOR, the Sailing Instructions, or the rules of the Larimer County Department of Natural Resources

3. Eligibility and Entry:

The event is open to female skippered and crewed boats. Skippers must be female members of CLSC in good standing, but need not serve as helmsperson. It is not necessary that crew or skipper be a lady, but they must be female or identified as such. All boats will sail in a single PHRF fleet.

4. Advance Notification:

Advanced Notification is highly encouraged. Boats may indicate their intention to participate by entering their name on the RC, Intent to Race spreadsheet accessible from the Racing Homepage on the CLSC website

5. Fees:

The Lady Wilson Victory Cup Regatta is conducted as a free community service. There is no entry fee. Larimer County Park passes for boats or vehicles will be available at the Marina or park entry stations.

10. Regatta Site:

The regatta site will be at the North Pines Area of Carter Lake, Larimer County Recreation Area, west of Berthoud, Colorado.

12. Racing Area and Courses:

Racing area will be shown on the Carter Lake Sailing Club Race Course Chart, available at registration.

13. Scoring:

The low point scoring system of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 will be used. All races sailed will be scored

14. Trophies:

The overall first place finisher will have her name engraved on the Lady Victory Cup trophy.
