2023 70 Anniversary Fun Race SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as listed below.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be given verbally at the skippers' meeting.

3. SAILING INSTRUCTION CHANGES

Any changes will be announced at the skippers' meeting at 12:30 pm.

4. SCHEDULE OF RACES

4.1 August 19, 2023 – 1 pm start

4.2 One race will occur, regardless of weather conditions.

5. CLASSES

5.1 There will be one class without any handicaps.

6. RACE AREA

6.1 The race course map on the CLSC web site shows the location of the racing areas and approximate location of the marks, starting area, "no wake" and "fishing" areas.

7. COURSES

7.1 The course to be sailed will be from the docks around mark 7 and back to the docks.

7.2 A boat must only use its motor on one leg of the race. In other words, it can only use its motor going out to mark 7 or coming back from mark 7.

7.3 All marks are left to port.

8. MARKS

Marks are designated 1,2,3,4,5,6, and 7. All marks are upright three-foot white and yellow plastic cylinders. Marks may have a red “cone” on top to improve visibility. Inflatable marks may be used and are red (R), yellow (Y) or orange (O). If inflatable marks are put to use, the mark will be designated on the course board by R, Y, or O.

9. THE START

9.1 A horn at the docks will indicate the start of the race.

10. THE FINISH

10.1 To finish, a boat must enter its slip and a crew member or the captain must go to the midpoint on the docks, take a shot of tequila and ring the bell. Bells will be located at the midpoint of both North and South Docks. An equivalent beverage substitute can be provided by a racing boat (alcoholic or non-alcoholic) prior to the skippers meeting. The beverage must be marked with the boat name and located at the bell location.

11. TIME LIMIT

11.1 Three hours

12. PROTESTS

13.1 No protests are allowed. The decision of the race committee is final.

13. SCORING

14.1 First boat back to the dock wins.

14. SAFETY REGULATIONS

14.1 Drinking is only allowed after the boat returns to the docks.

15. LIABILITY, RELEASE AND WAIVER AGREEMENT
