

Carter Lake Sailing Club (CLSC) welcomes you to participate in the 2021 Carter Lake Regatta Series. Our Regatta Series offers multiple options for participation. The Series will be held on seven different weekends throughout the season. Races will be scheduled on both Saturday and Sunday each weekend, but competitors may elect to race Saturday's only, Sunday's only, or both days. Scoring throughout the season will be posted as if all participants were sailing both days. Final scoring and prizes will depend upon season wide participation in each of these three options, with Saturday only and Sunday only participants segregated as such.



## 1. EVENTS

The Carter Lake Sailing Club (CLSC) will conduct a single, season long regatta series. CLSC is the Organizing Authority. All Races will be held on Carter Lake, west of Berthoud CO.

### 2. RULES

This Regatta Series will be governed by the 'rules' as defined by the 2021-2024 *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) except as changed by this NOR, the Sailing Instructions, the rules of Larimer County, and any and all guidelines, federal, state and county, concerning covid-19 safety practices.

### **3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be available on the CLSC website, <u>www.sailcarter.org</u>, on or before Friday June 12.

### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all self-righting (keel) boats. One design fleets with three (3) or more entries will be recognized as a class. Anticipated classes are at least two PHRF classes. Additional classes may be established at the discretion of the Race Committee. Classes may be formed into divisions for starting purposes & courses.
- **4.2** Registration is not required. Non-CLSC members are welcome to participate, and will be scored, but will not be eligible for any prizes.

### 5. FEES

- **5.1** There are no fees associated with this event, it is offered as a benefit to club members, and as a public service to non-members.
- **5.2** All participants are responsible for their own park passes and lodging.

### 6. SCHEDULE

### 8. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded based on the number of competitors in each class:

Classes with 2 – 3 boats will have a first-place trophy awarded Classes with four boats will have a first and second place trophy awarded. Classes with five or more boats will have a first, second and third place trophy

awarded.

Additional prizes may be awarded at the organizing authority's discretion

### 9. VENUE

All races will be held on Carter Lake

# **10. SCORING**

- **10.1** The Low Point Scoring System in the RRS Appendix A subject to modifications as defined in the Sailing Instructions.
- **10.2** The race committee will assign handicaps for boats entering the handicap (PHRF) class without S.A.I.L. PHRF certificates, not subject to appeal.

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
